DRA

The Developmental Reading Assessment is a set of individually administered criterion-referenced reading assessments for students in kindergarten through grade 8. Assessments are conducted during one-on-one reading conferences as children read specially selected assessment tests. The DRA is designed to inform and shape instruction.

Scholastic Reading Inventory

The Scholastic Reading Inventory (SRI) test is used to determine each student's reading ability, using lexile scores as a measure. The SRI is a computer adaptive assessment instrument for grades 1-12 that allows educators to assess reading comprehension.

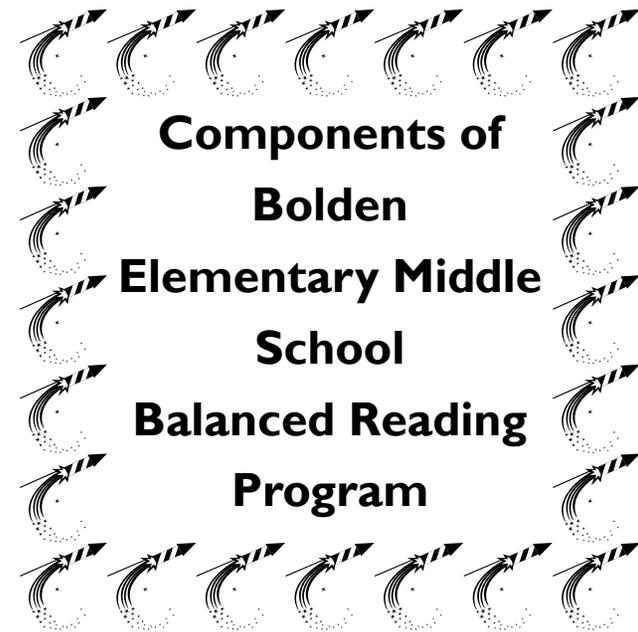
How to Soar to the Top
