## **2012-2013 INFLUENZA VACCINE CLINIC**

- Flu vaccines (spray and shots) will be administered again at all Laurel Bay Schools on **5 October 2012 (Friday)** starting at 12 Noon. This will be the only Influenza Vaccine Clinic at Laurel Bay Schools this SY.
- The 2012-2013 flu vaccine will protect against 3 strains of influenza virus: A/California/07/2009 (H1N1), A/Victoria/361/2011(H3N2), and B/Wisconsin/1/2010.
- The FLU vaccines are being offered to students, staff and other military dependents (parents and/or siblings).
- Students can receive their 1st or 2nd dose of their FLU vaccine at this clinic even if their first dose was not given at the school.
- **Please note:** Some children under the age of 9 years old need 2 doses to be protected. Those students will be notified of the need for two vaccines upon assessment at the flu clinic and notification will be sent home. Please make the appropriate arrangements with your child's PCM for the second FLU vaccine. Also if this is your child's **2nd vaccine dose**, please provide the date that the first dose was given. The second dose of a recommended 2-dose series should be administered at least 4 weeks after the initial dose.
- If all questions #6-15 are answered "NO" by the parent, then your child will receive the Flu MIST, Not the Shot Vaccine. All children less than 2 years of age will receive the flu shot. Any child that has a 'YES' answer to any questions #7-15 must have clearance through their physician in writing or by fax to receive the FLU Shot at the school's Flu Clinic or have the parent present for further questioning.
- Parental consent forms will be sent home with all students. If additional copies are needed for other children in the household or yourself, please contact your child's school nurse. **All immunizations require** a consent form. (Only one person per consent form please). Please read & complete the **medical screening questions on** your child's parental consent form carefully, signing and returning only the student's form to your school nurse by **Monday, 1 October 2012**.

No vaccine will be given without a completed/signed consent form.

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**ANY CHILD THAT IS WITH PARENT CONSENT BUT UNWILLING TO BE VACCINATED WILL NOT BE VACCINATED AT SCHOOL.**
