**I. Neighborhood Schools** (by Housing Zones)

Students living on Ft. Benning entering grades 9-12 in the fall automatically qualify for entry into either Spencer High School 4340 Victory Drive, Columbus, GA or Chattahoochee County High School 350 Hwy 25, Cussetta, GA. Both are considered our "neighborhood high schools" and both provide advanced, on grade level and remedial classes to accommodate all academic levels.

**II. Magnet Academies-Columbus, GA**

Columbus, GA high schools which focus on specific interest areas are called "Magnet Academies" and have eligibility requirements before a student is accepted in to their programs. Students who qualify for these programs may be required to meet certain overall GPA requirements (usually B/ better average in each 8<sup>th</sup> grade class), submit report cards signed by their school counselor, take an entrance exam, obtain teacher recommendation, compose an essay as to why they wish to attend their magnet program and complete an individual interview process. Students interested in attending a magnet academy are strongly encouraged to maintain honor roll type report cards every quarter of their 8<sup>th</sup> grade year. Students should also attend the high school's open house program scheduled between January-April. Specific dates to be announced!
