

Butner Elementary Supply List

***All students need to wear tennis shoes daily (closed toes and heels) for safety during play. Please purchase bookbags without wheels to ensure hallway safety.**

Prekindergarten

1 Large Labeled Book Bag (no wheels & large enough to hold a folder without bending it)
1 Box of Crayons (8 count)
1- Large Package of Baby Wipes
1- White 3-Ring Binder (1-1/2 inch with Clear Plastic Pocket Front) (This will be his/her portfolio and will be returned at the end of the school year)
1- Package of Document Protectors (50 Count)(This is also for the portfolio.)
1- Change of Clothes (Label with child's name in a Ziploc Bag)
Markers (washable) Please make sure it has primary colors.
1 Pack of Playdough-Brand name Playdough works much better and lasts longer.
1 box of Kleenex
1 – Crayola water colors
3 – Glue sticks
1 bottle of Elmers School White Glue
Tennis shoes to be worn daily to school
Please bring supplies to open house or have them ready for your home visit. Thank you.

Kindergarten

Label with child's name

- 1- book bag with child's name on the outside (No animal-shaped or book bags with wheels) *Simple ones without lots of zippers are much easier for your child to manage when packing and unpacking their belongings.
- **BATH** size towel (No mats or beach towels please); labeled with child's name
- 1- large t-shirt (large enough to fit over clothing for painting, labeled with child's name) This does not need to be new.
- A complete change of clothes; including underwear and socks, packed in a Ziploc bag with child's name (to remain at school)
- Tennis shoes to be worn daily to school

Non labeled items- these items will remain at school

- 8- pack of large-tipped washable markers
- 2- boxes of tissues
- 2- boxes of 16 colors small crayons
- 1- box of 8 colors large crayons
- 1- bottle (8 oz) of Elmer's white "Glue All". **NOT** Elmer's School Glue
- 3- dry erase markers; slender style, black
- Boys- 1 box of snack size plastic zipper bags
- Girls- 1 box of sandwich or quart size **Easy Ziplock** plastic bags (with the plastic slider)

Your child's teacher may request other supplies for her classroom. Please bring the supplies listed with you to your child's orientation appointment

First Grade

Please label the following items with the student's name:

1 Spiral Notebook – 1 subject/wide line
2 Primary Composition Books
2 Boxes Crayola Crayons (16 to 24 Count)
Fiskars Scissors for kids with pointed tip
School Box – No larger than 9x6 (like a cigar box) *No zippered pencil pouches
Backpack without wheels that is large enough to hold folders and books
1 Expandable Folder with 6 pockets or more for portfolio
Art Shirt – An old **OVERSIZED** T-shirt
\$10.00 for Weekly Reader Subscription, Folders, Cardstock and Poster Board

Please do not label the following Classroom Community Items:

10 Glue Sticks
2-4 Pink Block Erasers
12 Yellow #2 Pencils
2 Boxes of Kleenex

Please place all items in a brown grocery bag with the student's name on the outside of the bag.

Second Grade

- (4) 2-pocket folders
 - (2) dry erase markers (large, black)
 - (24) Pencils (no mechanical)
 - (2) Boxes of 16 crayons
 - (4) Erasers – large rectangular shaped (Pink Pearl)
 - (2) highlighters one pink and one yellow
 - (10) glue sticks
 - Scissors
 - 12” plastic cm/inch ruler
 - (2) Wide-ruled composition notebooks (black and white marble cover) No spirals
 - Hard plastic pencil box (approximately 6”x9”)
 - (1) 1 ½” New white 3 ring binder w/ clear front cover pocket
 - (30) clear document protectors
 - Art shirt (an old large size T-shirt works best)
 - Backpack with no wheels
 - (2) boxes Kleenex
 - 1 pack index cards
 - 1 box Ziploc freezer bags (gallon)
- Please do not bring pencil sharpeners or pencil toppers to school.

Please place your child’s name on all supplies, and bring to orientation in a grocery bag with your child’s name on the outside of the bag.

- 2- spiral notebooks (one subject notebooks)
- 2 – red pens
- 2 – highlighters(yellow)
- 2 – pink erasers
- 1 – book bag (no wheels)
- 1 – zippered pencil bag (cloth type-NO pencil boxes)
