

Parents can facilitate success




Parents play a key role in ensuring that their child

*** monitor where your child goes / information**

*** encourage students to participate in school-**

related after-school activities

*** consistently enforce household rules**

*** set aside a time when the whole family reads**

*** encourage students to talk about school, social**

activities and their interests

*** teach standards of right and wrong and demon-**

strate these standards

*** provide a quiet place where your child can study**

*** support school discipline policies**

*** talk to your child about tobacco, drugs, alcohol,**

gangs and violence

*** monitor your child's choices of TV programs,**
