

Behavior Policy

It is quite often in my class that students pick from our prize box. We call it the "caught doing something good" card and I hand them out frequently. Students get them for anything from sitting correctly while writing to picking up a piece of paper off the floor. The students love it and it encourages them to do their absolute best. It would be greatly appreciated if you could donate to the box periodically. Small toys, books, and snacks are perfect, no candy please!!

Other times another type of card can be handed out. The first card for inappropriate behavior yields a warning and no consequence is given. The second card pulled is a partial loss of recess while the student writes a letter to whomever they wronged. The third card pulled is when we notify the parent of inappropriate behavior that day. The student will write a letter to you explaining their actions.

The rules and colors are as follows:

Red- I will talk at the correct times.

Yellow- I will complete my work and do my best.

Purple- I will be caught doing something good.

Blue- I will be kind and respectful to everyone.

Green- I will listen and follow directions.

Black- I will be responsible for my school supplies.
