**HOMEWORK:**

**1. HOME READING!** This is THE most important part of your homework!

Please read **AT LEAST 20 MINUTES** at least 20 days in each month. **Remember to keep your home reading folder in your child's binder.** Part of the 20 minutes may be used for working on alphabet or sight word flash cards. Also, check out our school's web page. Click on the cyberlibrary to find great learning games!

**\*Please have your child draw pictures of 3 of the books you read each week. Have them write their name on the top of the paper and return to school by Friday.**

**2.** I will send home a **little book** (made of paper) each week that is simple enough for our students to read with minimal help. Please don't throw these away! Your child can read them over and over! **The students still need to hear adults read, but they should be reading some, as well.**

**3. Sight word:** Find at least 3 of the word **"your"** in newspapers, magazines, etc. Cut out and glue onto any piece of paper. (You may circle words with a crayon first if it helps.) **OR**, write at least 2 sentences with **"your"**. Bring in by Friday.
