ONLINE LUNCH PAYMENT IS HERE

Want to Pay lunch fees and check your child's lunch balance online?

A new technology available to the Fort Campbell Community School District allows parents to track what their children are purchasing in the school cafeteria.

Internet website LunchPrepay.com provides access to a 45-day history of what students are buying for breakfast and lunch.

Parents will receive premium membership on a secure site to prepay for school meals, track history of food purchases, and have the assurance of knowing lunch money they send from home actually makes it to school. If a child's account becomes low on funds parents receive low balance alerts by e-mail.

Using LunchPrepay.com removes the stress that comes with making sure children have money for lunch and ensures they are making good nutritional choices.

Any parent who enrolls a student in LunchPrepay.com will need the students ID number. This student ID number is not the 3-4 digit lunch room pin number. In order to obtain your students ID number, please contact the Child Nutrition Department.

There is a 5% charge, when a parent adds money to their student's account. (Example, if a parent adds \$20. on their students account, after that 5% fee is added the total cost would be \$21 for that transaction).

Reading Counts

There will be a Reading Counts Assembly on October 21st at the following times:

Grades 1-2 9:30-10:00

Grades 3-5 10:15-10:45

This assembly will be to recognize students that achieved their Reading Counts goal for the 1st quarter.

The 2nd Quarter of Reading Counts will begin on October 14th. Listed below are the requirements for each grade level. The last day for students to achieve their goal for the 2nd quarter is December 17th.

Grade 1 20 points

Grade 2 20 points

Grade 3-5 6 non-fiction chapter books (w/i the student's lexile)

**All students that reach their goal will attend a Reading Counts Celebration and will be recognized at the Reading Counts Assembly.

Students must have an overall average of 80% correct to participate in the events mentioned.

The goals for students to achieve their Reading Counts T-shirt are:

Grade 1 80 points

Grade 2 100 points

Grade 3 120 points

Grade 4 140 points

Grade 5 160 points

Students must read within their lexile and have an average of 80% correct.

Their picture will be posted on the bulletin board by the gym.

Thanks for your support at home by having your child read at least 20 minutes daily.

Reading Counts is an incentive program to encourage students to become successful, independent readers. This program does not influence their Reading grade.
