The Reading Goals for the 1st quarter are:

- Grade 1** Reading Logs (consult classroom teacher)
- Grade 2** 20 points
- Grades 3-5** 6 fiction chapter books (at least 3 points each)

**\*\*All students must have an overall average of 80% or higher to achieve their goal.**

The last day for students to get points is October 7th.

Students that achieve their goal will be recognized in an assembly. Parents will be invited.



Students that achieve their goal will also attend a Reading Counts Celebration

**T-Shirt Point Goals:**

- Grade 1** 80 points
- Grade 2** 100 points
- Grade 3** 120 points
- Grade 4** 140 points
- Grade 5** 160 points

**\*\*All students that achieve their T-shirt goal must have an **overall** average of 80% or higher.**

Points toward the T-shirt goal are acquired throughout the year.
