Curkendall Named to Community Superintendent Post

PEACHTREE CITY, Ga. – Dr. Elaine Beraza, Director, Department of Defense (DoD) Domestic Dependent Elementary and Secondary Schools (DDESS) today announced that Mr. Todd Curkendall has been appointed as the Fort Knox Community Superintendent.

Dr. Frank Calvano, Kentucky District Superintendent, said Curkendall will gradually transition into the position, but will continue as the principal of Fort Knox High School until a replacement is hired. He will fill the position left vacant when Mr. Michael Minutelli accepted a position at the DDESS Area Service Center in Peachtree City.

“Curkendall has a wealth of knowledge of and varied experience with our Fort Knox schools,” Beraza said. Curkendall has been with the Fort Knox schools for 14 years. He was hired in 1992 as a teacher. Since 1998 he has been principal of Scott Middle School and Mudge Elementary School and became principal of the high school in 2000. He has experience teaching grades K-12 in science, social studies and physical education.

A native of West Virginia, Curkendall earned his bachelor’s degree from Morehead (Ky.) State University, his master’s degree from Austin Peay State University and completed advanced leadership coursework at Western Kentucky University.
