A NOTE FROM THE NURSE

According to *DoDEA Health Service Guide, DS Manual 2942.0*, school personnel may administer medications when certain criteria are met.

The medication will be in the original container, **properly labeled by the pharmacy or physician**. The date of the prescription must be a current date. The pharmacy label and the doctor's instructions on the permission form **MUST** match in all of the following areas:

- Student's name
- Doctor's Name
- Medication's Name
- Amount of medication to give
- Time/frequency to give medication

1. Non-prescription medications such as Tylenol, Motrin, or cough medicines will not be administered unless **prescribed by a physician and are in a pharmacy labeled container**.

2. Medications will not be sent home with students. It is against school policy for students to have any medication in their possession at school.

This includes non-prescription drugs such as cough drops.

Dismissal Procedures

Our process beginning Tuesday, 13 November 2012 will be as follows:

- Walkers will be dismissed at 2:45. Also, club participants will be released to their designated area at this time. *It is important to know that if you walk up and get your student each day, then he/she is considered a walker and will be dismissed at 2:45. Kindergarten students must be released to a parent based on post regulations. Kindergarten students listed as walkers who do not have a parent at the school at 2:45, will be sent back into the building and the parents must sign them out in the office. This process is to ensure that we can begin car pool in a timely manner.
- CYS Students will be dismissed to the Lunchroom at 2:47
- Car Riders will be dismissed once all walkers (supervised and unsupervised) to include parents are away from the front of the building.
