I _____ authorize _____ do not authorize my student's work (art, writing, etc.) to be featured in school, in the local or national media, or on the Internet. I understand that my student will retain the copyright privileges of originally produced work.

Note: Within DoDEA guidelines, photographs of students featured on the Internet will not be associated with their names.

I release the Fort Knox Community Schools and its personnel from any liability connected with the (a) tapings, recordings, public displays or photographs of my student or (b) use of those tapings, recordings, public displays, or photographs.

I grant this authorization and release because I favor the promotion of the Fort Knox Community Schools and the community it serves.
