

Important Information for Camp Lejeune Dependent Schools Parents & Students

Inclement Weather

In case of severe weather or emergency situations, a decision regarding school closing or delay may be necessary. These decisions are made by the Superintendent of Schools after consultation with weather bureaus and other base agencies.

Please DO NOT CALL the school or Superintendent's offices. As soon as a decision is made, local radio and television stations are notified, along with LC-TV. In addition, a recording is placed on the Base Information Line – 451-1717, option 5 for schools.

NOTE: Onslow County and Camp Lejeune are separate education agencies and make decisions based on different criteria.
