Recognizes the impact of individuals on a global society




Recognizes landforms

Math— The students will learn to measure length using different units of measure. They will also begin the unit of double digit addition and subtraction.

Standards:

Estimate and measure the length of common objects to the nearest unit.

Explain and perform addition and subtraction for two-digit numbers
