


PreK Progress

Curriculum Standards

The student begins to develop abilities necessary to do scientific inquiry.

Asks questions about objects, organisms, and events in the immediate environment.

Conducts simple explorations through observation and play.

Identifies measurable attributes and uses these to make comparisons among objects.

Acquires knowledge of the alphabet when provided with experiences that present letters in ways that are meaningful to their lives.

Sorts and organizes concrete data by similarities and differences.

Learns that letters of the alphabet are a special category of visual graphics that can be individually named.
