

Fifth Grade Supply List

- A STURDY 3-ring Binder with 2-inch metal rings or larger (zippered Five-Star Binders are highly recommended and have proven to be the most durable/economical in the long run)
- Five Subject dividers for the 3-ring binder
- A slim pencil case to put in the 3-ring binder
- Six solid color pocket folders WITHOUT metal brads
(so they can be hold punched and put into the 3-ring binder)
1 Red, 1 Yellow, 1 Green, 1 Blue, 1 Orange, 1 Purple
- A larger eraser to use when writing or drawing
- A standard 12 inch ruler (with metric units on opposite side)
- Several # 2 pencils
- One package of small dry erase markers
- Protractor
- One roll of scotch tape
- Wide ruled loose leaf paper (no college ruled)
- One full size box of tissues
- A small box of crayons
- Colored pencils and/or markers (optional)
- Scissors
- 3 Glue Sticks
- A pencil/crayon box that snaps or fastens closed for your desk
(big enough to fit crayons, scissors, tape and glue)
- Two Composition notebooks (they usually have black and white covers)
- One 3 or 5 subjects spiral notebook
- Two highlighters (pink or green only)
- An erasable pen with blue or black ink
- A ball-point pen (any color ink except blue or black)
- Tennis shoes for P.E. (no black soles if possible)
- One package white lined 3x5 index cards
