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## Reading/Language Arts

### Phonemic Awareness/Phonics/Comprehension:

We have learned:

- short a, i, o, e
- final ck, x
- initial blends
- -s plural
- Inflected ending – ing (ie: jumping – happening right now) and s (ie: jumps - does not make a word plural)

**Grammar:** Your child has learned about the subject and action part of a sentence. They have also learned about word order to make a sentence make sense (ie: Dog the jumped high or The dog jumped high). They are able to identify sentences that are telling sentences or questioning sentences.

**Comprehension:** We have read fantasy, realistic fiction and non-fiction stories. The students can identify the genre of the stories they have read. They have also learned about characters, setting, main idea and cause and effect within a story. Ask them question when you read together nightly.

## MATH Home Links

We are working on telling time. Children know the hour hand and minute hand on an analog clock. We are working on ordering numbers. Practice telling the number that comes before and after a number.
